8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; 9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

Paul explains here how we are saved and what we are saved unto

Saved BY grace (vs. 8-9)

1. Vs. 8 begins with the word “for” how do vs. 1-7 demonstrate God’s grace?
2. What is the difference between salvation as a gift and salvation by works?
3. How does faith connect us to God’s grace?
4. Paul makes clear that there is no ground for boasting, what is the proper response to salvation instead of boasting?

Saved UNTO works (vs. 10)

1. How does vs. 10 reaffirm what was said in vs. 9?
2. How does our situation in vs. 10 differ from our situation in vs. 1-2?
3. How do we know what good works God’ has prepared for us personally?
4. What is the difference between “working in our works” and “walking in His works”?
