1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, 3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Paul tells us that in response to all the truths of chapter 1-3, we should respond by keeping the unity in the Body of Christ

Striving for Unity (vs. 1-3)

1. What things come to mind from the first 3 chapters that Paul is calling us to walk worthy of here in vs. 1?
2. Verse 3 says that we need to work to preserve unity. How do the traits listed in verse 2 serve that goal?
3. How do we see these traits in the life of Jesus?
4. How do the truths in the first 3 chapters relate to the traits in vs. 2?
5. Why do we need to preserve the unity of the church?
6. Being diligent in vs. 3 implies the possibility of giving up on unity. Is there an area in your life where you may have given up on preserving this unity?
